for beauty honesty sheer weirdness and a haunting evocation of place kevin sampsell is my favorite oregon writer ken kesey chuck palahniuk make some room on the shelf sean wilsey author of oh the glory of it all kevin sampsell s a common pornography is a memoir told in vignettes that captures the history of one dysfunctional american family an extension of a 2003 memory experiment of the same name a common pornography weaves recollections of small town youth with darker threads from his family s story including incest madness betrayal and death a regular contributor to dave egger s the believer and mcsweeney s sampsell has written the kind of book where you want to thank the author for helping you feel less alone with being alive jonathan

chronicling five years of a troubled romance this is between us offers an intimate view of one couple s struggle from the illicit beginnings of sexual obsession to the fragile architecture of a pieced together family full of sweet moments emotional time bombs unexpected humor and blunt sexuality the daily life of this man and woman both recently divorced with children and baggage in tow emerges in all of its complexity in this utterly engrossing debut novel kevin sampsell delivers a confessional tale of love between two resilient people who have staked their hearts on each other
